Rules and Regulations

1. Use only tags that are issued. Do not use old tags. Entry tags will be available to fill out when items are dropped off or can be picked up at the P&H Centre or the Hanover Public Library prior to August 6.
2. All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form in order for prize money to be awarded.
3. No exhibitor can make more than one entry in each Section.
4. No entry fee in any class.
5. All produce from home gardens and grown from seed and attractiveness of display to count.
6. **Exhibits must be picked up at 3:00 p.m. and no later than 3:30 p.m. Sunday, August 9th, 2026.**
7. Prize money will be sent to the school in the fall.
8. Parents are urged to allow their children to do all the work in preparing their exhibits without assistance. Encourage them in every way but remember that the work parents do for children defeats the object of the Fair which is to teach the boys and girls to do things themselves. It is the children's fair, help them to make it a success. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE CHILD'S OWN WORK.**
9. Please be sure to enter your exhibit in the right age group. Age groups are determined by the grade you finished in June 2026. For example, if you finished grade 3 in June, please enter into the grade three section.
10. If there is a high number of entries in a section the judges may decide to divide it into two sections and award a second set of prizes.
